#### **INFORMATION**



Saratov was founded in 1590 as frontier garrison on the Volga to protect merchant ships on this waterway from being robbed. In the 1760's, colonists primarily from Germany settled in Saratov and the surrounding steppe near the Volga River. Saratov grew from a small provincial outpost to become one of the largest and most prosperous cities in Russia. Saratov today has a population of about 1 million and became a big industrial and cultural city. One of Russia's best-known composers, Alfred Schnittke, whose mother was a Volga German, was born in 1934 in Engels, located just across the river from Saratov, K. Petrov-Vodkin (1878-1939) and V. Borisov-Musatov (1870-1905), both celebrated artists native to Saratov. There are more than 15 Universities are now in Saratov. Saratov State University (SSU) is one of the oldest Russian universities, established in 1909. Today's university is an academic and research complex, a cultural and social center with 15 faculties and more than 20 000 students.
